For a number of years Barbara and I have been involved in mission work, both state side and abroad. Our first real taste of mission work was in Upper State New York. We also worked in the state of Georgia, which remains a mission field even until now. In the early nineties we moved to the Country of Albania and helped to establish the first congregation of the Lord's Church in that country. This was soon after the fall of Communism. In addition to these works we have been involved in other mission efforts in several states here in the U.S. and other countries.



Early this year we began a new program of work known as **World Mission Radio**. This work involves more than just doing radio program although this is a great part of our work. As has been the case for many years we continue working with Mt. Sinai Bible Camp and Christian Academy and also Obonga Village Orphan Home. Recently we began a Spanish Speaking radio program that covers all of the Latin American Countries, most of the U.S., and parts of Canada.

The idea of a Bible Camp in Kenya, the first in all of E. Africa among our Brethren, was conceived in the minds of Brother Jones and some of our Kenya Brethren as they were visiting at the sight, on one occasion. From that point brethren at Mauche began prayerfully considering such a project. In 2006 that idea became a reality and from a very humble beginning Mt. Sinai Bible Camp and Christian Academy has become, not only a reality, but a great success. The Academy and Bible Camp, for the most part, were self supporting from it's inception.

Although great progress is being made there yet remains much to do in order to accomplish all that we want to accomplish. begin a training preachers



with a computer training school, in the near future. Brethren in the congregation at the camp are planning to construct a new church building as they have allowed the Christian Academy to take over the existing church building. Also, plans are to build additional building for the camp, when possible.

We also are in need of purchasing additional property for the school.

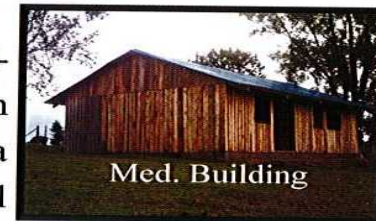
