Just Read It

The mother of Jesus told the servants at the wedding feast in Cana “do whatever He tells you” (John 2.5).

Jesus is the Word, and He told us to know Him (John 17.3).

How well do we follow that? Do we “*know*” like we should from reading?

The *Bible in America Study* reports that 62 percent of the people in the communities surrounding our churches would like to read the Bible more. Another study reports 87 percent of the people in our churches want help understanding the Bible better. Bible reading is low. Recent studies demonstrate that in one generation the number of occasional Bible readers has fallen by 20 percent - the equivalent of 700 people per day. If this trend continues, by 2040 two-thirds of Americans will have no meaningful connection with the Bible. We cannot know the Jesus of the Bible, if we don't read our Bible.

Nehemiah asked Ezra the scribe to bring the Book of the Law of Moses. Ezra read God's Word from daybreak till noon in the presence of men, women, and others (Nehemiah 8). Why would Nehemiah want the people to hear the Word of God?

The people understand and know God. I visited one of our members in the hospital. In the room, they had brought their bible, and it was opened. The couple had been reading from it. What a great example!

Whether sick or well, just read it. Whether happy or sad, just read it. Whether in need or want, just read it.
