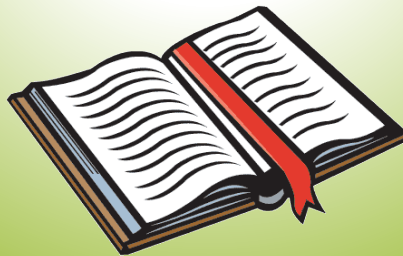

## Applying the Gospel – Good News Should Make Us Feel...

Can you imagine not having joy when you hear that your newborn baby is healthy and fine?  
Can you imagine not expressing joy when the person you want to spend the rest of your life with says “yes”?  
Good news should make us feel joy.

What about the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ? Do we feel and maintain joy of knowing and growing in the “Good News”? Joy is a theme that repeats itself throughout the Scriptures. “*You have filled my heart with greater joy than when their grain and new wine abound*” (Psalm 4:7). When God’s people returned to Jerusalem and rebuilt the wall, Nehemiah told them, “*Do not be grieved, for the joy of the Lord is your strength*” (Nehemiah 8:10). The growth of the early church is portrayed as the spread of joy (Acts 8:8). Jesus told His disciples in the upper room, “*These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full*” (John 15:11).

We confuse joy with trying to live life our way. It’s easy to think that way because it’s advertised and demonstrated. We find joy by seeking God. We treasure God as our greatest joy. When we live and grow for Him, we have this great source of joy that will sustain us through difficulty. We best enjoy life by living for God. This is all possible because of the Good News.  
Doesn't that make you smile spiritually?

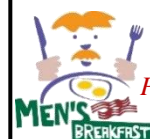
