Better Love

I can easily use the word “love” to describe things. “*I love watching college football.*” “*I love eating a steak or a bowl of turnip greens.*” “*I love to spend time with my family.*” “*I love the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.*” “*I love my beautiful wife.*” “*I love that catchy song.*” You get the picture. We overly use the word “love”. I can say “*I love this meal*” and turn around and tell my wife “*I love you*”. Is my love the same for my wife as it is with a good meal? I think not.

The Greeks had many words for love. Each word was a specific type of love. “*Phileo*” is a companionship, liking, affection type of love. “*Agape*” is unconditional love. “*Storge*” is love based on natural affection or obligation. They would use the word for love to describe different relationships or situations. We just have “love”. This doesn’t mean that we cannot know the fullness of what “love is”. We have many verses and examples of what love is from God. One of the most well-known places is the love chapter of the Bible, I Corinthians 13. This passage was not written to be used in weddings, for anniversaries, or to be hung above the mantel in the home. Paul wanted us to know a more excellent way than the miraculous measurement of the Holy Spirit.

We will spend the month of February studying this more excellent way so we can come away understanding **Better Love**.

A – Attitude of Christ

We embody the **Attitude of Christ** in order to build each other up, offer encouragement, and be a positive light in the world.

You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. (Matthew 5:14 NKJV)

The statement above is the next piece of our **IMPACT** statement and is a very important quality that all Christians should possess. But what does it mean to have the **Attitude of Christ** or to be the light of the world? First, we have to focus on building each other up, especially our Christian brothers and sisters. Second, we should offer encouragement at all times and avoid any forms of discouraging actions or words.

In today's society, it seems anytime you watch the news, read the paper, or check social media there is something negative or discouraging. Unfortunately, the church is not exempt from this negative or discouraging thought process. And in many cases, we don't even realize how what we do or say actually impacts someone else. Do you encourage the people in your life or just tell them what they are doing wrong? Do you encourage the young people and those participating in the service, or do you only discourage them by saying something negative or saying nothing at all? Do you promote the works of our congregation or spread negativity if it's not the way you like it? We often think that everything needs to be perfect and nobody can make mistakes. The truth is that we all make mistakes and don't perform at our best all the time, and it's in those times when we need the most encouragement.

Our goal, as an Eldership, for 2019, is to be better encouragers, and we hope that each member can do the same. Search your heart and contemplate how people would describe you. Would they see you as an encourager; someone who is active in the work of the congregation; exudes an attitude of Christ; supports the Elders and leaders and is making an **IMPACT** on others? Or would they see you as a discourager; a complainer; never happy about anything; not involved; upset that things aren't done your way? When was the last time you complemented the preacher, the communion presider, the song leader, those reading scriptures or leading prayers, the teachers, the Elders, or the Deacons? By providing encouragement to someone, they will gain confidence to continue improving. In closing, we all need encouragement which is also emphasized in the following verse.

And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting [encouraging] one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.
