Ruth 2:10-13 (NKJV)

Have You Considered?

Have you considered the people in your life? What about where you live? Do you ever think about the things that have happened to you?

When our son, Noah, was born, we prayed for a door to open for us. We wanted to move closer to a set of grandparents. We found an opportunity in West Nashville with the River Road congregation. In our time there, we grew to love the people and the community. That whole time, without my knowledge, I had a tumor growing in my brain. It would take a special doctor, who happened to be a member at River Road at the time, to help. She led me to the right neurosurgeon. What are the chances of that happening? It had nothing to do with chance. I believe it was the providential care of God.

My family is here at Charlotte Heights, and we feel led the same way as we did over 12 years ago. You have your stories, too. The people we befriend and the places we go happen to be what we need at that time in our lives. If we stopped to look at our present life, it would look like a cobweb of connections from one person to another. It involved events, jobs, good times, and times we struggled. All of it would come together for the good for those who love God and are called to His purpose.



We are invited to see the webbing of Ruth and how she would be connected to the Messiah. We get a brief snapshot of a family in the time of the judges. What Ruth gives us is something for us to consider. God is not just a God of nations. He is also a God of individual lives. He cares for the world, but He also cares for you.

Maybe we need to be still long enough to consider the number of ways God is blessing us.
