Reputation

What do people say about you? How are you known at work? What about in your family? There were two brothers known to be notorious in a small town. They drank, cheated, and were mean to people. One of them had died, and his brother went to see the local preacher about a funeral. He said to the minister, "I want you to call my brother a saint." The preacher replied, "I can't do that! Everyone knows that he wasn't a saint." The brother insisted by saying, "I'll give one thousand dollars to your congregation if you call my brother a saint in the funeral service." On the day of the funeral, the preacher got up and said, "We all know that the dearly departed was an unfaithful drunk and a cheat, but compared to his brother, he was a saint!"

We are considering a recipe worth remembering. We have looked at the ingredients of determination and consideration. We continue in the book of Ruth and look at a third ingredient. It's an important ingredient. It's needed if we are going to influence others. Ruth was a foreigner. She was a Moabite. She had no Jewish heritage in her blood. There was no need for Ruth to pretend like she was one of the Israelites. She didn't do that. She was a woman of integrity, and she established a good reputation. Ruth had built such a good reputation that Boaz recognized that all the people in town knew her to be a virtuous woman.



I think what others see and hear from you says something about you. I can tell you all day that I am wonderful and that I am helpful. However, it means more to hear that from someone else. We can all talk the talk about ourselves. What is our life saying? Would they use the word "virtuous" to describe us?
