Recipe to Remember

Fourth Ingredient: Redemption

Ruth 4:8-10 (NKJV)

8 Therefore the close relative said to Boaz, "Buy it for yourself." So he took off his sandal. 9 And Boaz said to the elders and all the people, "You are witnesses this day that I have bought all that was Elimelech's, and all that was Chilion's and Mahlon's, from the hand of Naomi. 10 Moreover, Ruth the Moabitess, the widow of Mahlon, I have acquired as my wife, to perpetuate the name of the dead through his inheritance, that the name of the dead may not be cut off from among his brethren and from his position at the gate. You are witnesses this day."

Redemption

The Japanese word “*kintsukuroi*” means “*golden repair*”. It is the art of restoring broken pottery with gold, so the fractures are illuminated. The artists believe that when something has suffered damage and has a history, it becomes more beautiful.

The book of Ruth opens with three funerals. A distraught mother-in-law tells her daughters-in-law to return home. She said, “*the hand of the Lord has gone out against me*”. (Ruth 1:13) We read of sorrow in the beginning. However, the story takes a change when Ruth goes with Naomi back to her town of Bethlehem. Ruth’s noble example caught the eye of a kinsman redeemer. He had planned to redeem Ruth and Naomi.

The fourth and final ingredient is the most important one. It’s redemption. The woman from Moab would be redeemed by Boaz. Redemption involves personal sacrifice. Boaz had the money and love to pay the redemption price. He was willing to redeem the land and the name of Elimelech. Boaz is a picture of our Redeemer, Jesus Christ. Jesus paid the price in full in His death on the cross. He did it because of love. A life marred by sin doesn’t have to remain broken. Christ can take our damaged soul and redeem it by His blood for the forgiveness of our sins. We have a lot of reasons to sing with our heart today. There is no greater reason than knowing that I’ve been redeemed by the blood of the Lamb.

✓ IMPACT Corner

This week's **IMPACT** Corner focus is on our bus ministry. This is an important work as we have 8 – 10 members each week that ride the bus to services when they would otherwise not be able to attend. It would be wonderful to extend this opportunity to others but sometimes the distance is too far to be picked up. In some cases, other members pick up and bring someone to church, which is also very important.

Daryl Downey is the deacon in charge of this ministry. He arranges for drivers, ensures buses are up to date on maintenance, and makes sure they are clean and ready to go. **Roger Lewis, John Green, Bart Bartlett, Russ Wilcoxson, Kory Crow, Jimmy Roberson, and Joel Wright** currently assist in driving on either Sunday or Wednesday. Other members have assisted in the past, and anyone willing to help can contact Daryl to get in the rotation and be added to the church insurance. The driver arrives at the building approximately an hour before each service to pick up the van and begin the route and then leaves immediately after services to return the members home. In total, it requires about 2 hours per service to fulfill this responsibility.

We also use the van or bus on other occasions such as youth activities, Friday night singings, and Senior functions. Joel or Daryl have driven groups to lunches or to view Christmas lights.

Let them know how much you appreciate their service.
