26 Now as they led Him away, they laid hold of a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, who was coming from the country, and on him they laid the cross that he might bear it after Jesus. 27 And a great multitude of the people followed Him, and women who also mourned and lamented Him. 28 But Jesus, turning to them, said, "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for Me, but weep for yourselves and for your children. 29 For indeed the days are coming in which they will say, 'Blessed are the barren, wombs that never bore, and breasts which never nursed!' 30 Then they will begin 'to say to the mountains, "Fall on us!" and to the hills, "Cover us!" What Jesus Saw

What goes through your mind during the Lord's Supper? What do you think about the most? Do you think about His death? His resurrection? Do you think of Christ from an eyewitness perspective? Have you ever thought of it through the perspective of Christ?

The powerful hymn "*When I Survey the Wondrous Cross*" was written by Isaac Watts. It was first published in 1707.

We imagine through the written words what it must have been like for Jesus.

*"See, from His Head, His Hands, His Feet, Sorrow and Love flow mingled down;
Did e'er such Love and Sorrow meet, Or Thorns compose so rich a Crown?"*

I often think about the pain and suffering He endured publicly. I think about the nails through His hands and feet. I imagine how hard it was to catch a breath by pulling His weight up. I look in shame because my sins put Him there. What was it like for Jesus?

What did He see? It's one thing to read of an event that has long passed. It's another for the One Who experienced it.



We will examine "What Jesus Saw".

What Jesus saw that day is the same thing He sees today. He sees people that love Him and follow Him. He also sees those who despise, insult, and curse Him. Let us consider what Jesus saw.

A lot of work has already been done, but there is more to do. Several lists in the foyer still have spots for people to sign-up.


We particularly need people to Decorate Tables, help with other Decorations, and bring food.

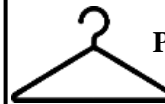

We are now collecting clothes for the new **Clothing Room**. Please bring the clothes to the Gym, and there will be a designated area to leave them.

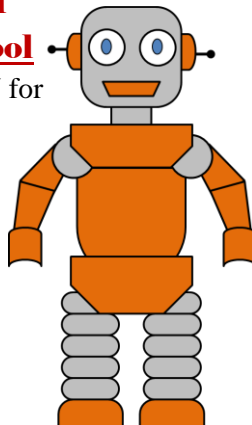


Please wash the clothes before you bring them, as we are still organizing this new ministry.
