Charlotte Heights!**

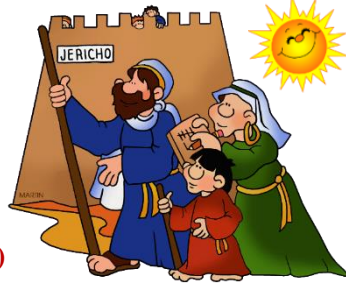

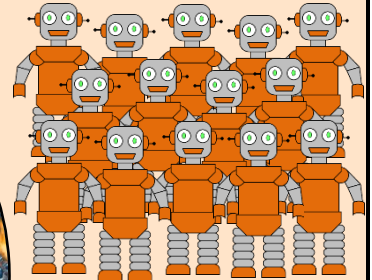
