Now Is the Time To Trust In God and Wait

“Then it came to pass, at the end of two full years...” (Genesis 41:1)

What could you do for two full years? Could you work a terrible job, if the pay was right, for two full years? Could you be in a bad relationship for two full years? What about prison? Could you be an inmate for two full years in another country?

This was Joseph. However, he didn't have a choice. I could do several things for two years, but prison is not one of them.

I don't know what it's like for a day, let alone a year in prison. Joseph was there because of mistreatment and false accusation. His brothers mistreated him by selling him off to the Midianite traders. Joseph had an opportunity to get out of an Egyptian dungeon. He interpreted the chief butler's dream. The chief butler was taken to the prison at the request of Pharaoh.

God worked through Joseph to interpret the meaning of his dream. The chief butler got out and was restored by Pharaoh.

Did he remember the one who helped him in prison?

“Yet the chief butler did not remember Joseph but forgot him” (Genesis 40:23).

I understand better that **“Now Is the Time”** to do something. What about **“Now Is the Time”** to wait? I prefer doing something rather than waiting for someone. I don't like waiting. I go to my Ten o'clock doctor appointment only to wait for another hour. We wait for the light to turn green. We are waiting for our turn to order in the drive-thru. We are waiting for the results of a test that was done. We are waiting to turn sixteen to drive. We can all relate to waiting.

How does this apply to **“Now Is the Time”**?

Joseph shows us the need to trust in God and wait. I don't know what he thought about every day for two more years in prison. I do know that the Lord was with him. I don't know the answers to a lot of “why questions”.

I do know that ***If God is for us, who can be against us.*** Sometimes we work. Other times we wait.

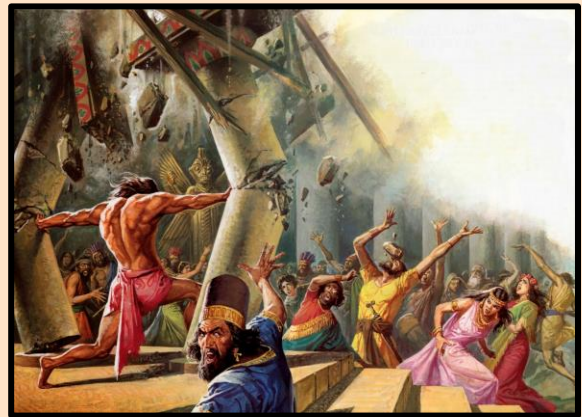

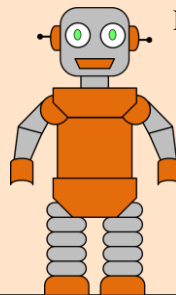


VBS Information Booth
