**Matthew 17:24-27 (NKJV)**

24 When they had come to Capernaum, those who received the temple tax came to Peter and said, "Does your Teacher not pay the temple tax?"

25 He said, "Yes."

And when he had come into the house, Jesus anticipated him, saying, "What do you think, Simon? From whom do the kings of the earth take customs or taxes, from their sons or from strangers?"

26 Peter said to Him, "From strangers."

## Fishing with Peter

Simon Peter was a fisherman by trade. He and his brother, Andrew, were heirs to a family business. Commercial fishermen caught three different types of fish on the Sea of Galilee. The small fish mentioned in the feeding of the thousands were likely sardines. (John 6:9) Sardines and a type of flat bread were a staple in that region. Another type of fish is a barbel. This is a type of carp that can grow to be as much as fifteen pounds. Several believe that this was the type of fish that Peter caught when a piece of money was in the fish's mouth. (Matthew 17:27) The third and most common type of commercial fish are musht. Musht are edible size ranging from six inches to a foot in length. There are restaurants near the Sea of Galilee today that serve fried musht. Musht are popularly known as "St. Peter's Fish".

We are casting our eyes toward the times Peter went fishing. Each time, Jesus was there fishing for Peter. We are reeling in what Peter learned on each fishing experience. We, too, can learn what Peter reeled in as well. In Matthew 17, Peter was told by Jesus to go out and cast a hook in the sea. It was under the instructions of the great Rabbi that Peter went back into his former profession. Why did Jesus instruct Peter to fish?

It had to do with the temple tax. Peter reeled in more than a fish. He reeled in the importance of responsibility. We are subjects to the Law of Christ and the Law of the land.

We are to be obedient to the establishments that God made.

**Check out the Display Table in the foyer to get information and see the curriculum.**

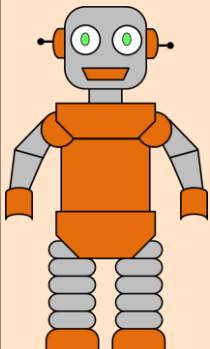
