

An Important Ministry

In 1901, Clinton and Mary Potter opened the doors of the Potter Bible College in memory of their son, Eldon. The school grew under the administration of James A. Harding. After his retirement, the school struggled and closed. In 1914, the Potters established the Potter Orphan Home and School. They immediately received 12 orphans cared for by a church in Louisville, KY. The Potter Children's Home has been caring for children ever since.

We have been asked to join them in prayer for the children around this world. I'm thankful for our Elders joining us along with other congregations throughout the body of Christ. We don't mean to, but we can overlook children in our prayers. We are so focused on the sick, dying, and lost that we can sometimes forget about the young in heart and mind. They need prayers, too. One of the highlights of my day is ending it with my boys. I hug them and offer a prayer to God for them. I thank God for the day, for them, and for being able to be with them throughout the night and day. I then kiss them goodnight. I hope they are learning how important God is by the prayers.

Children need to see our care for them in order to know that God cares.

Jesus took the time to show the value in children. When the disciples rebuked those bringing children to Jesus, He was greatly displeased with His own disciples. He said, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God" (Mark 10:14). How can we go wrong if we take the time to pray for our children and the children throughout the world? We can't. We need to take the time,

just as Jesus took the time, for children. I believe they are an important ministry. Yes, we need to pray for the sick and reach out for the lost. We also need to take the time to invest in our children's faith.
