Voices from the Dead

By Josh Barnett
Hebrews 11:4-7(NKJV)

4 By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it he being dead still speaks.

5 By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, "and was not found, because God had taken him"; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God. 6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

Beyond the Grave

I had a visit recently with a dear friend of our family. He had some major health issues which included hallucinations. He said, "I hope you never have to experience hallucinations." He went on to tell me that he saw the ceiling fan come closer to him while the ceiling fell down like a balloon. His wife told me that he believed he had seen his mother calling for him. He was crying and reaching out to her. The doctors have regulated his medicine better, and he has no more hallucinations.

Can you imagine hearing from or seeing the ones passed away? If it was possible, what would you say to your deceased relative or loved one? Would the shock be so overwhelming that you would be frozen in fear? Would you be flooded with the love that you have for that person? I'm not saying that this can or will happen. However, we do have a record of voices heard beyond the grave. What they say speaks volumes of what we should be doing today!

The Hebrew writer gives example after example of demonstrated faith. The first one mentioned is Abel. We know that Abel offered a more excellent sacrifice than Cain. God was pleased with Abel's sacrifice. The Hebrew writer adds this about Abel: "*he being dead still speaks*" (Hebrews 11:4). Abel still speaks to us today from beyond the grave. What does He say? What about the others? Although deceased, they still speak to us. Will we take the time to consider what they are saying to us?



Can we see the value and worth of their words from beyond the grave? May we consider the important lessons from those beyond the grave.

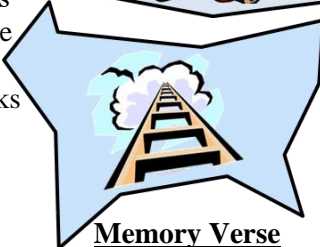
Time Tunnel Caverns

We have now lost a tour guide at **Time Tunnel Caverns**. That makes a total of 6 people who have been taken into the Time Tunnel by the mysterious man.

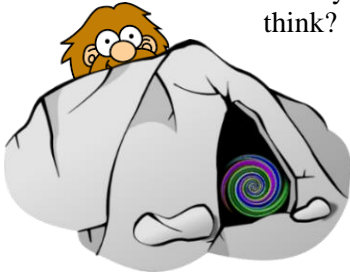
Last week, we learned that Jacob sold his birthright to his twin brother, Esau, for a bowl of stew.

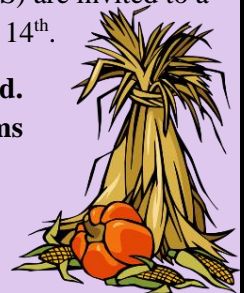
