A Thankful Act

Mr. Anders of Louisiana spent 45 years bending down and collecting something that most of us ignore. How many of us bend down and pick-up a penny from the ground? I asked this to my Sunday School class a couple of weeks ago, and only a few raised their hands. Mr. Anders did this for 45 years. When he was 73 years young, he took all the collected pennies to the bank. It took 15 five-gallon jugs to haul all the pennies collected. It took the bank machines five hours to count all those pennies. The grand total was \$5,136.14. In an interview, Mr. Anders said, "I became convinced that spotting a lost or dropped penny was an additional God-given incentive reminding me to always be thankful." Every dropped or lost penny reminded Mr. Anders of how thankful he was for God.

It doesn't take much to possess a spirit of gratitude. It can be a small act. It can be as simple as picking up a penny or hearing "thank you" from someone. I wonder how Jesus felt when He healed ten lepers but only one came back to thank Him. The math is not good. Only 10% said, "Thank you." The one cleansed leper moved Jesus to say, "Go your way. Your faith has made you well." (Luke 17:19) It's one thing to be well physically. It's completely different to be well in faith. We may not think it's much, but it matters to God. It matters for us to take the time to thank Him. We can do that by our worship and service to one another.

We can do that in prayer and Scripture reading. It's as small as the amount of a penny.

However, it's as great as pleasing God.

"In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." (I Thessalonians 5:18).
