Luke 17:11-19 (NKJV)

11 Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. 12 Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. 13 And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

14 So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.

15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, 16 and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan.

17 So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? 18 Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" 19 And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

Thankful Life

“In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”
(I Thessalonians 5:18)

How many times did you hear “Thank You” this past week? How many times did you say, “Thank You”? I wonder if our gratitude is tied more to our circumstances rather than to our condition with God. I go back to the lepers in Luke 17. All ten were sick. All ten needed help. Jesus healed all ten, but only one grateful person came back to say, “Thank You”. One out of ten expressed gratitude to Jesus in Scripture. Would the same hold true today? Would only ten percent be grateful with their surgeon after a successful surgery? Would only ten percent of civilians rescued by soldiers be thankful? Are there only ten percent thankful for being redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ? Is ten percent too high or too low among people’s gratitude with God?

I cannot speak for others, but I can speak for myself. I need to look carefully at the words of Paul and examine my day and life. Do I demonstrate “*in everything give thanks*”? If we have been cleansed by the blood of Jesus, we cannot go on living as if nothing happened to us. How can an ungrateful attitude or life be a part of us? We must not be known as the other nine lepers in Luke 17. We must not go through a day or moment as if God hasn’t made a difference in our lives.

May it be said of us that we are living a thankful life.

4th Annual Mission Sunday – December 8

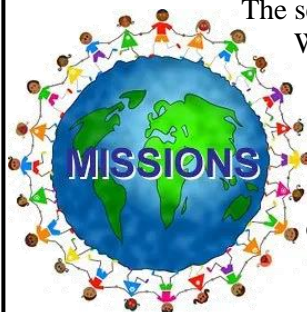
We will have our 4th Annual Mission Sunday on December 8th.
