Angels We Have Heard on High

It seems to be happening earlier each year than the last. I was curious while driving if a local radio station was already playing Christmas music. Sure enough! It was already in the full festive rotation of holiday selections between religious and secular songs. We can go from hearing “*Last Christmas*” to “*O, Holy Night*” before the commercial break. Every year newer versions of Christmas songs are played. How many different ways can we sing “*Jingle Bells*”? I enjoy listening to Christmas music when it’s after Thanksgiving. However, I prefer the classic carols. I believe the words of these classical carols capture an extraordinary event in human history.

We don’t know when Jesus was born. The first recorded time in history of people celebrating the birth of Jesus on December 25th was in a Roman calendar in 336 A.D.

In fact, for the first three centuries of Christianity’s existence, the birth of Jesus wasn’t celebrated at all. In 2019, the birth is celebrated by many along with Frosty, Rudolph, and Santa Claus.

I want us to spend time this month looking at classical carols that capture an important event in history. The birth of Jesus Christ was an event unlike any other. It demands our attention to the facts and not the fictional things that have been created throughout time. We begin with an old carol that speaks of the heavenly ministers of God.



“*Angels We Have Heard on High*” captures the incredible relationship between Heaven & Earth, God & man, and angels & shepherds. We know from the scripture that angels are interested in God’s redemptive plan. We are told that the angels rejoice when one sinner repents (Luke 15:7).
