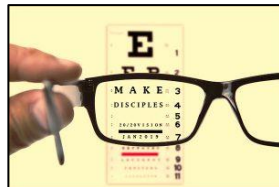
20/20 Vision

Today, the Elders will take the time to share with us the works we will support in 2020. I wanted to take the time and share with you a glimpse into our new series beginning in January. I call it "20/20 Vision". I know it's not original. But, I believe it's important for us to have a vision for our church today and into tomorrow.

What do I mean by vision? A lot has been said on the subject at hand.

George Washington Carver said, "Where there is no vision, there is no hope." Hellen Keller said, "The most pathetic person in the world is someone who has sight but has no vision." Alexander Graham Bell said, "When one door closes, another opens, but we so often look upon the closed door that we do not see the one that has opened for us." What about in the Bible? "Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he" (Proverbs 29:18, KJV). Some other translations say "revelation" instead of "vision". I don't believe we have to reinvent the wheel when it comes to church growth. We are not left without a vision or revelation. We have the translated copy of the Words of Christ.
