## Christ in Carols

The word "Carol" can mean "joyful song; to sing with joy and festivity". I was reminded of the power of a carol when we sang to those fighting cancer. We bravely sang carols to the guests at Hope Lodge. The Hope Lodge is a free housing site for people receiving treatment for cancer. We went through the traditional carols of "Rudolph", "We Wish You a Merry Christmas", "Santa Claus is Coming", and "We Wish You a Merry Christmas". Their eyes lit up, and some of them cracked a smile because of the familiarity of the carols. Many were appreciative of the singing of the carols. It touched my heart to see the power of music. I was reminded of Saul with David. Saul's only relief from a distressing spirit from God was music. David would take a harp and play it with his hand. Saul would become refreshed and well, and the spirit departed from him. (1 Samuel 16:22-23).

One of the people there at Hope Lodge was John. He was facing a second round of cancer. His wife was cancer-free for 20 years and recently got a different type of cancer. She was up in the room and unable to come down. He was so exhausted from life that he was emotional when he spoke. He was so thankful for the meal, fellowship, and carols. I love these carols not because I believe that we know the exact day of our Lord's earthly birth. I love how they can uplift our troubled spirits. They connect us with others in a way like no other. They tear down barriers and walls of people that know we are of a church.



What would this time of year be like without the carols? Where would that extra sense of giving and doing for others be without that carol's melody in our hearts? Our next carol, "It Came Upon the Midnight Clear" speaks of Christ and His interest of those who are less fortunate. We are to help the helpless. We are to reach out to the outcast. We are to be a light to those fallen in darkness. It was at night that the brightest light came.
