2020 Vision – Redefining Evangelism

What is Evangelism? I can easily define it by looking up the word. However, what is it? You may say, "It's the Great Commission". I would say, "Yes, but what is it?" Is Evangelism only defined as preaching and teaching the gospel to someone? Is that the only way to "make disciples"? Jesus said, "*Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit*" (Matthew 28:19). The command in the Greek is to "make disciples". How do we go about that? The traditional approach has been an in-home Bible study, Gospel meeting, and going door to door. I grew up thinking that Evangelism was an event, like worship. We plan an event and evangelize during that time. I believe we limit the power of the Great Commission when we reduce it into a schedule event.

I believe Evangelism is every day and, in every way, helping a non-believer.

I will not forget a couple from Millington, Tennessee. I was the guest speaker for the day. I spent time with one of the Elders and his family. His wife told me that she was a Christian, but her husband was not. She didn't force her faith upon him with ultimatums. She lived out her faith every day. It took many years, but she influenced her husband because of her constant faith to Christ. He obeyed and later became an Elder. This person was won to Christ not by a singular event but in everyday life.

If we are letting our light shine, we are committing ourselves to everyday Evangelism. I believe many are looking for Truth, but they want to see authentic Christianity. This cannot be done by a week-long Gospel meeting or an openness to an in-home Bible study. It is what we say and do day-in and day-out.

It's every day and, in every way, helping your non-believing friend or family member to take steps closer to a relationship in Jesus Christ.

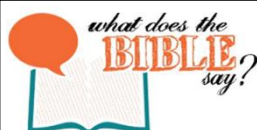

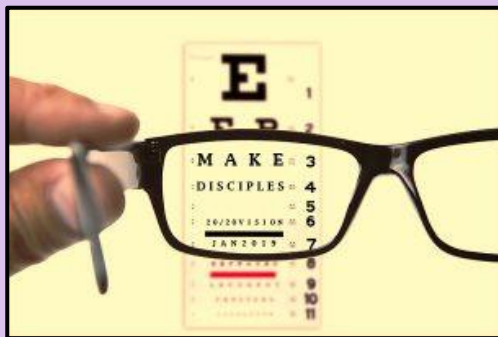
