Redefining Evangelism – Part 2

The last time I was in the emergency room was in August. Thankfully, I was able to get relief from my pain and eventually go home. Before I left, the doctor gave me a shot to help me before sending me home. I had the craziest side effects from it. I couldn't control my body for the next 36 hours. I was constantly moving and fidgeting, and I was unable to be still. My heart was racing, and I felt helpless. It was a little unnerving during that time because my body was unable to work together. It wasn't listening to what my brain was telling it to do. I wanted to stop moving, but I couldn't. Isn't it frustrating when our body doesn't function as it should?

The Lord's church is compared to a body. Please see I Corinthians 12. I believe the best approach to evangelism is with the Lord's church. It involves the entire spiritual body. We wouldn't consider doing anything with only a part of our body. Imagine going on vacation with everything but your arms or legs. We wouldn't like that nor do we expect that. Why would we look at evangelism with only a few people doing it? Why would we minimize it to just a couple of people? I've yet to find in Scripture an example of a local church growing because of one person or a few. The church grew because the church was on fire for the Lord and people. We are redefining evangelism every day and, in every way, helping people to come closer to Jesus. How do we do this? We do it as one body. We work together with all our varied talents and abilities towards the same goal. The Lord's church is the best approach to evangelism. It takes a church to grow a church. It takes a church to evangelize. It takes a church to work and grow in the Lord. It takes a church because we are a part of the spiritual body of Christ. I am a part and not the answer. I am at my best when I am working alongside other members. May we continue in prayer as we ask God to help open our hearts and spiritual eyes to see the opportunities of those without a relationship with Christ. It will only work if we all see that the church is the best approach to evangelism.

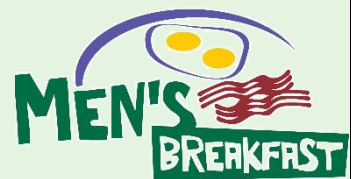
