Redefining Evangelism Part 3 – The Bodily Approach

Imagine picking up leaves in your yard with a toothpick. How long would that take? My parents have a lot of tall trees in their backyard. My father is still mulching up the leaves and sticks that have fallen. If I mentioned that to him, he would look at me as if I'm crazy because he has a John Deere. Imagine trying to cut down a tree with a single razor blade. What about cutting your yard with a pair of scissors? I saw a video from North Korea where people are assigned to cut the yard in front of an important government building and manicure the landscape with a small pair of scissor-like blades. Can you imagine doing that every day for your entire adult career? Obviously, we wouldn't think to do things this way because it's not practical or efficient. We all understand that, when it comes to everyday living.

We are *Redefining Evangelism* this month. The command from Jesus is clear to "make disciples" (Matthew 28:19). How we do that is up in the air sometimes. Is it with missionaries, preachers, elders, or deacons? Is it with people who are younger or older? Is it with extravert people only? I believe the Bible is clear that it's for the entire church to do. One of the greatest passages that speaks to this is when Paul compares the Lord's church to the human body. "If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as He wanted them to be." (1 Corinthians 12:17-18)

The human body works together as one. Each part is designed specifically for a function. The church works together as one. Every member is designed for a specific purpose. Evangelism is more practical and efficient if we all do what we are designed to do. Some of us can teach. Others can encourage and listen. Some can faithfully pray without forgetting. Others are extroverts and easily befriend and invite someone. It's a *Bodily Approach* to help bring someone closer to Jesus. It takes the entire body of Christ to be that "city set upon the hill". We can do evangelism with only a few people to do it, but it wouldn't be practical or efficient.

It takes a church to grow the church.

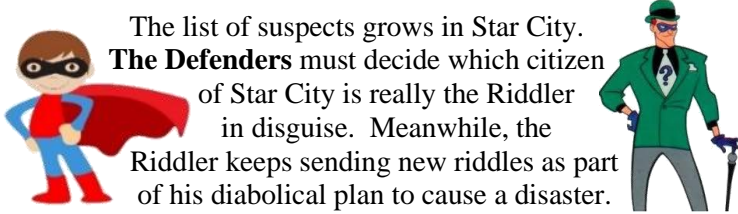

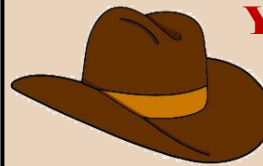

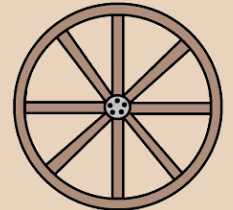
We have finalized our date for the Young-At-Heart Banquet.

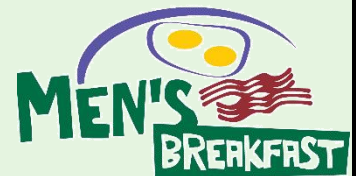
