Redefining Evangelism Part 4 – The Metaphors of Evangelism

“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” (Matthew 28:19)

We are **REDEFINING EVANGELISM** by what we do every day and every way, bringing people closer to Christ. The ultimate goal is for one to be in Christ. The reason is not for us to have more in numbers. It's not for us to raise our contribution. The reason is to save a soul from eternal death. It's fulfilling God's ultimate will for all to repent (2 Peter 3:9). I cannot stress the importance of the things one must do to be "in Christ". One is not "in Christ" if one is baptized but fails to repent and confess.

One is not "in Christ" if one isn't baptized but repents and confesses. Confession is necessary for one to be "in Christ" (Matthew 10:32-33). Repentance is necessary for one to be "in Christ" (Luke 13:3). Belief is necessary for one to be "in Christ" (John 8:24). Baptism is necessary for one to be "in Christ" (Matthew 28:19).



How does someone get to that point to make that most important decision for themselves? It takes light, salt, and planting on a continual basis. The metaphors of evangelism are to help us understand the importance of our influence. I look at my life as an example. I became a Christian because of Christ. I was led to Christ by the influence of others. I'm forever indebted for the godly example of the people God placed in my life, the ones who evangelized to me by their relationship and influence. I'm thinking the same reasons apply to you. Our daily evangelism is best described as light, salt, and planting. May we continue to be prayerful about our influence to bring someone we know to Christ.

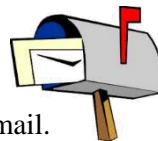

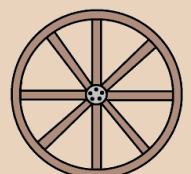
