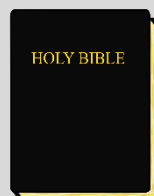

## Reflections of Evangelism - The Greatest Evangelist

Is there anything that is original? Is there something that hasn't been done or learned from somewhere else? We have learned from others who have taught and shown us. It really came clear to me as a parent. I'm constantly under a microscope by three sets of eyes who are watching what I do and say. I might be guilty of aggravating my sweet wife. Maybe one of the boys can see me do that and try to do the same. How can I get on to them when it's my fault? I might say something silly, and they go and say it constantly. They are like tiny computers downloading everything we are saying and doing. Sometimes I want them to delete some of my poor decisions.

We are focused on Evangelism. Our theme verse is Matthew 28:19. "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit". We REDEFINED EVANGELISM to make it more practical in our everyday life. We said that Evangelism is what we do every day and in every way to bring others closer to Christ. It's our job as light and salt to point people to Jesus.

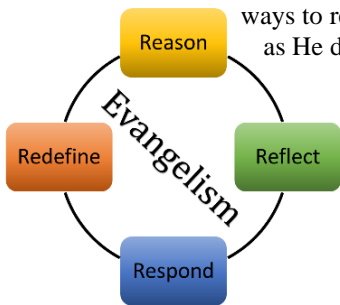
The second word for us to consider is "Reflect". What do I mean by that? I want us to spend time reflecting on those who show us how to evangelize. If we learn from others how to do other things, why not in the area of evangelism? There is no better place to start than with Jesus. He is by far the greatest Evangelist. He made it clear why He came to earth. He came to seek and save that which is lost (Luke 19:10). What I notice when I study Jesus' life is that He wasn't confined to doing things one way. He used various

ways to reach the lives of others. He would go to where they worked as He did for James and John. He would sit and eat with sinners.

He would heal someone from a distance to prove His power and the person's faith. We can learn a lot from the Master when it comes to being evangelistic.

Let's take the time to reflect on the greatest life when it comes to evangelism.

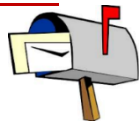

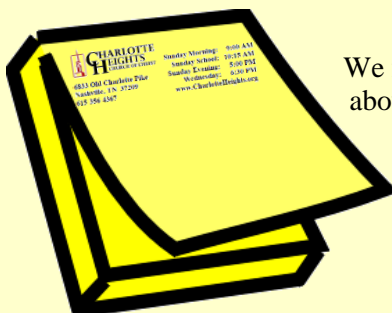
