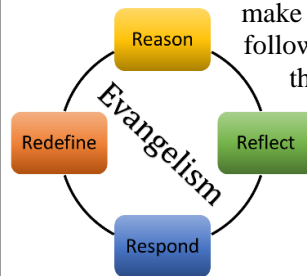

## Reflections of Evangelism – Don't Forget Your Family!

Do you think Noah was a successful preacher? Do you think he would be hired by churches today? Did he win a lot of souls through the message of God? Did he change the attitude of a community? Was he a dynamic speaker? Noah listened to God in a time when that was uncommon. The only souls saved were Noah's family. "Who formerly were disobedient when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water" (1 Peter 3:20). As a father, I admire Noah because of his influence in a time when negative influences prevailed. He had three sons, and all three sons and their wives were saved. He was 100 percent with his immediate family when it came to salvation through water. I don't just look at Noah and his wife. The three sons were old enough to be married, and they were old enough to make their own decisions.

What about the first family? There was no pattern for them of a good and bad parent. They were the original parents. They raised both boys to love and sacrifice to God. However, one went against what he was taught by his parents and God and committed murder. God punished Cain and not his parents.

We are Reflecting our time on those who evangelized before us. One of the greatest evangelists was Andrew. He teaches us that we cannot forget our family. Andrew encountered Jesus and ran home to tell his brother, Simon. Andrew could have run into town or into the synagogue. He could have run to the local fish market to tell his buddies. He went home first to tell his brother. We are focused on being the light to our community. We are to be a city that is set upon a hill. We cannot forget to be a light at home. We have the tremendous responsibility to teach the gospel to the ones we call "family". They're no different than someone we don't know. They have to make the decision for themselves to follow Jesus. Some decide to follow Him, and some do not. We don't give up on them because they are family. We can pray, encourage, and invite. We cannot lose heart in doing good because they are family. Andrew teaches us the importance of family when it comes to evangelism. Don't forget your family!
