Reflections of Evangelism: Philip By Josh Barnett **Acts 8:27-35 (NKJV)**

27 So he arose and went. And behold, a man of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen of the Ethiopians, who had charge of all her treasury, and had come to Jerusalem to worship, 28 was returning. And sitting in his chariot, he was reading Isaiah the prophet. 29 Then the Spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot." 30 So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, "Do you understand what you are reading?" 31 And he said, "How can I, unless someone guides me?" And he asked Philip to come up and sit with him. 32 The place in the Scripture which he read was this:

"He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; And as a lamb before its shearer is silent, So He opened not His mouth. 33 In His humiliation His justice was taken a way, And who will declare His generation? For His life is taken from the earth."

34 So the eunuch answered Philip and said, "I ask you, of whom does the prophet say this, of himself or of some other man?" 35 Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture, preached Jesus to him.

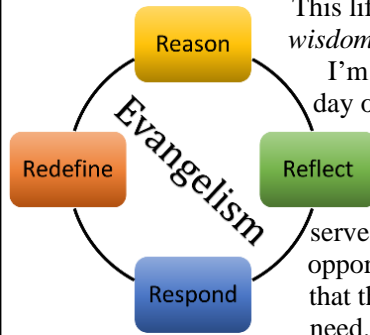

Reflections of Evangelism

Be Open, Available, and Aware of Daily Opportunities!



This life requires a heavy dose of Colossians 4:5. *“Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time”.*

I’m guilty of living many days for myself. I think, “It’s a day off”, or “I’m on vacation”, or “I’m too busy right now.”

Have you ever driven past someone needing help and had similar thoughts? Have you ever thought that way with an announcement about an opportunity to serve others? I believe we can all relate to wasted days and opportunities in our lives. Jesus made it clear in the parable that the Samaritan was on his way when he saw someone in need. The traveler was on his way from point A to point B.

I read where a Bible professor tested his students by placing someone in need on the way to class for their final exam. Those who stopped to help the person made an A on the final. Those who didn’t missed the mark.

Please don’t misunderstand me. I’m not saying we must constantly be working with no time off. I’m just saying we need to be open enough to God. We don’t need to live a life so wrapped up in ourselves that we miss an opportunity to invite someone to church. We are often so engaged in ourselves that we overlook a way to help someone and show the love of Christ. I do not believe that there is no one interested in spiritual matters in our community. I strongly believe there are people all around us who are searching for something.

Philip is an example of someone available to do the work of God. Philip had been in Samaria preaching Christ to a crowd with many needs. He wasn’t speaking to a multitude of people who had their lives together. He wasn’t among people who had all their needs met. He was among people who were possessed, paralyzed, and practicing sorcery. Philip focused on the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, and both men and women were baptized. In this great revival, an angel of the Lord called Philip away to one person traveling down from Jerusalem. God is interested in crowds, but He also cares for the individual soul. Philip was available, open, and aware enough to leave and go as told. Are you?
