Reason for Evangelism - Jesus Is Enough!

I had a great conversation with a couple from the Hope Lodge on Monday. This was his second bout with cancer. He had beaten it four years ago. He and his wife live in Hickman County. They talked about their two children and grandchildren. We also talked about faith in God. He said, "I wouldn't make it without it!" I thought about our conversation later. Cancer, pain, and suffering weren't greater than the reason to share our faith.

I believe if our reason is greater than our excuses, we are more willing to evangelize. I wonder if one of the reasons why we may feel frozen spiritually is because we have forgotten the true reason. We are unwilling to share the Good News or let our light shine because of the wrong reason. The reason to evangelize is not because of Charlotte Heights. The reason is not because of a sermon series by the preacher. The reason is not a desperate appeal by the Elders to grow and raise our contribution. The reason for evangelism is simply the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus.

In other words, Jesus is enough!

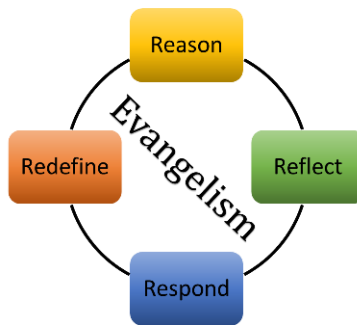
If my reason is not because of Jesus, I'm not so willing to evangelize. What's the point? Why put myself out there with a stranger if my reason is for something far less than Christ? We are simply going through the motions if we are not compelled by the love of Christ. Please compare your fear and worry to Christ. What is greater?

The worst someone can say or do is to reject us or say "no" to our invitation. If only Jesus was told "no".

He was beaten, mocked, ridiculed, and sentenced to death by crucifixion. And for what? We will not receive the same treatment for our faith. Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection give us the reason we need to thaw out from our spiritual slumber and invite, share, and/or study with someone. Jesus is enough!

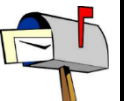
