Mark 15:21-27 (NKJV)

21 Then they compelled a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, the father of Alexander and Rufus, as he was coming out of the country and passing by, to bear His cross. 22 And they brought Him to the place Golgotha, which is translated, Place of a Skull. 23 Then they gave Him wine mingled with myrrh to drink, but He did not take it. 24 And when they crucified Him, they divided His garments, casting lots for them to determine what every man should take.

25 Now it was the third hour, and they crucified Him. 26 And the inscription of His accusation was written above:

THE KING OF THE JEWS.

27 With Him they also crucified two robbers, one on His right and the other on His left.

Reason for Evangelism - It Means Nothing!

What does it look like to have little to no meaning? What does a cheerleading squad sound like when they believe their team isn't the best? What does a child think if his or her teacher doesn't teach with much meaning? What marriage would succeed if there was little to no meaning? We are not made by God to go through the motions. Jesus didn't purchase the church with His own blood only to find His spiritual body living halfway for Him. We are not meant to be frozen or stuck in our faith. Jesus risked too much for us to settle for anything less than what He desires.

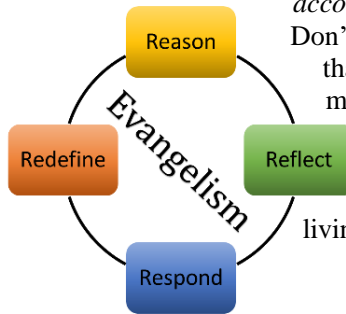
I came across an interesting quote from a book. *"I could not in good conscience tell a friend about a faith that didn't excite me. I couldn't share something I wasn't experiencing. And I wasn't experiencing Christianity. It didn't do anything for me at all. It felt like math, like a system of rights and wrongs and political beliefs, but it wasn't mysterious; it wasn't God reaching out of heaven to do wonderful things in my life. And if I would have shared Christianity with somebody, it would have felt mostly like I was trying to get somebody to agree with me rather than meet God."* Does that sound like you today? Christianity is set on habits or rituals that you go through each week. Our light is for everyone and anyone. We cannot settle for little if we believe in a God who is great. It's important to reassess our reason for anything spiritual. I cannot share my faith with anyone if I don't fully believe in what I am sharing. I cannot be light, be salt, or plant the seed if my spiritual gauge is on "E" for empty.

"Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us..." (Ephesians 3:20)

Don't miss what Paul is saying! There is tremendous power that works within a true believer, power that cannot be measured in imagination and in vocabulary. We must believe it enough to live it and show it. We must understand that our reason for sharing is greater. It must be more than numbers and contributions. We are living examples of the power of Jesus Christ. Live like it!
