*Reason for Evangelism: The Darkness, Temple, & Confession*

**Mark 15:33-41 (NKJV)**

33 Now when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour. 34 And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" which is translated, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" 35 Some of those who stood by, when they heard that, said, "Look, He is calling for Elijah!" 36 Then someone ran and filled a sponge full of sour wine, put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink, saying, "Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to take Him down." 37 And Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last. 38 Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. 39 So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was the Son of God!" 40 There were also women looking on from afar, among whom were Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James the Less and of Joses, and Salome, 41 who also followed Him and ministered to Him when He was in Galilee, and many other women who came up with Him to Jerusalem.

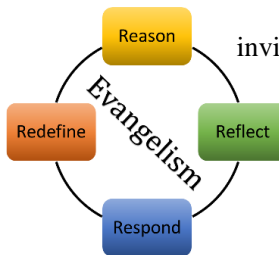

## Coronavirus (COVID-19)

**Charlotte Heights considers the health and safety of our members to be of the utmost importance.**

The World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the Coronavirus (COVID-19) to be a pandemic. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), most people in the United States have little immediate risk of exposure to this virus. However, it is likely that person-to-person spread will continue and that, at some point, widespread transmission of COVID-19 in the United States may occur.

There are many things that organizations and individuals can do to prevent the spread of this or any virus.

### Charlotte Heights has implemented the following steps.

- The building was thoroughly sanitized during the Congregational Building Workday.
- Extra sanitation processes are being performed on a weekly basis, including disinfecting door handles, water fountains, faucets, tables, pews, etc.
- Hand sanitizer and tissues are readily available for use throughout the building.
- We are sanitizing the bus/van before each use.
- We have provided gloves and hand sanitizer for those who count the contribution.
- We are providing the Communion in individually packaged containers for those who would like to use them. **The regular Communion trays will continue to be passed so that each person may decide how they want to partake.**
- We continue to provide online access to our services for those who need to stay at home.
- We have implemented online contributions, or you may mail your contribution to the church office. You may pick-up our Online Giving Instructions on the table in the Welcome Center or from the church office.

### We suggest that individuals take the following steps.

- If you are sick, limit contact with others as much as possible. **Stay home if you are sick.**
- Decrease personal contact (Hugging, Shaking Hands).
- Especially avoid close contact with sick people.
- Cover your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze and use a tissue, if possible.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Consider bringing your own hand sanitizer for use at your seat after the Communion and Collection trays are passed.

We realize that some of these are commonsense suggestions, but it is good to keep them in the forefront of your mind.

**We will continue to assess the situation and make adjustments to our plans and schedules as needed to keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible.**
