To the End

I want you to think about traditional wedding vows. You may not be married, but you can still see the point. *“I, _____, take thee, _____, to be my wedded husband/wife, to have, to hold, from this day forward, for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, to love and to cherish, till death do us part.”* Obviously, the point is to last through both prosperity and adversity. The married couple will have times of success and times of challenges. It's not a relationship to be taken lightly and walk away at the first sign of hardship.

I'm writing this article on the same day that I'm writing the eulogy for Nell Caldwell. James and Nell were married for sixty-eight years. Others have demonstrated the same length, maybe more. The point is that you stay committed and see through till the end.

What about our relationship with God? Hosea was the first prophet to mention committing adultery with God when we sin. (Hosea 4) We are in a committed relationship with the Lord as obedient Christians. How long are we to continue in this relationship? Do we leave when the going gets tough? Do we give up because life is tough & difficult?

Christianity is a lived-out, faithful relationship to God. It's a lifestyle that includes all phases and seasons of our lives. It's important to start well, but it's necessary for us to faithfully see this relationship to the very end of this life. How do we keep on going on in a time of unknowns and uncertainty? How did other people do it? I want us to consider a timely message of *“To the End”*. *“Many things about tomorrow, I don't seem to understand; But I know who holds tomorrow, And I know who holds my hand.”*
