John 15:22-27 (NKJV)

22 If I had not come and spoken to them, they would have no sin, but now they have no excuse for their sin. 23 He who hates Me hates My Father also. 24 If I had not done among them the works which no one else did, they would have no sin; but now they have seen and also hated both Me and My Father. 25 But this happened that the word might be fulfilled which is written in their law, 'They hated Me without a cause.'

Another Paraclete: The Truth Is Not Always Easy To Tell

Some truths are easy to share. It's no trouble to tell anyone the answer to a math question like, "What is 2 + 2?" We don't have any trouble telling someone the date and year. We can easily share the truth about the history of our government with the Presidents and the branches of government. These truths were taught to us at an early age. Unfortunately, every truth is not as easy to share as simple facts. Other important truths are more difficult to share. We may not feel comfortable in sharing with someone that Jesus Christ is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. We may not jump to run and tell that there is only one name under heaven with which we can be saved. If you struggle to share your faith with a stranger, you are in the good company of the disciples in the upper room.

Jesus was open to His disciples in the upper room. He told them that He was leaving, and they could not go with Him. He revealed to them their troubled and scared hearts. (John 14:27) However, He comforted them with the promise of another Paraclete. The other Paraclete would help them bear witness of the life, works, and teachings of Jesus Christ. They would depend upon the Paraclete when it came to testifying to a crowd that was not receptive to their teaching. The atmosphere for the apostles was not always favorable towards their Christian teaching. Many opposed and despised what they had to say. Jesus warned them. "If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you." (John 15:18-19).



The world continues to be a problem for Christian teachings and principles. It's obvious when we physically gather on the first day of the week. We have empty spots in the pews. There are enough people in Nashville to overfill every church building in Nashville. We are not alone when it comes to sharing the Truth. We have the help of one another. More importantly, we have the help of the other Paraclete. God is with us and at work. Mom was right. Always tell the truth. In Him,

However you connect - Stay Connected!

Conversations with God - Stop, Drop, Listen (Psalm 85)

Questions to Think About

- 1. Why are so many people attention starved?
- 2. Why is it so hard for so many to listen?
- 3. If you only had 1000 words left, how would you use them?

Psalm 85 is a prayer for restoration and revival.

A. Get Still

- We live in a society that doesn't like to be still enough to stay at home for too long.
- The psalmist is being still enough to focus his time and attention on God.
- His attention was on God, alone.

B. Get Quiet

- "I will hear what God the Lord will speak..." (Psalm 85:8).
- The problem wasn't with God speaking but with the ability to listen to Him.
- See Ecclesiastes 5:2-3.
- A great way to learn to listen to God is to listen to others.

Conclusion

- It takes great effort to get quiet and listen.
- When we learn to be still enough to listen, it helps us to focus our attention on God and not others.
- It also shows how much we love Him.
- Consider the silent pause of a prayer.
