The Assurance of God's Help

Don't we need to be reassured in life? How many times have you told your child that everything will be okay when a bad storm rolls in? How many times do you want to be reassured from the surgeon about an upcoming procedure? How many times do you need to be reassured that everything will be okay? I don't know of anyone who doesn't want some sort of assurance about upcoming events. It's human nature to want to know that everything will be good and fine. If not, we want to be aware of it as soon as possible.

The disciples had the assurance of Jesus' physical presence for three years. He was there to help, assist, guide, rebuke, exhort, and challenge. He was there, constant in their discipleship. In the upper room, Jesus told them that He is going away. They were troubled, afraid, and their hearts were filled with sorrow. I don't blame them for feeling that way. I believe we would all feel the same way. We struggle with abrupt changes that make us feel uncertain or unassured. We easily put things in our lives to help us feel more safe and secure. What happens when those things are taken away?

The disciples were no different than us. They needed to be reassured of God's help during this difficult transition. They would be tested and tried but not abandoned by God. Jesus' final statement about the Paraclete involved assurance for the disciples when Jesus was gone. *"However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth"* (John 16:13).

The other Paraclete helped by guiding them into all truth. They would have a better picture of things because of the work of the Spirit of Truth. We, too, can be assured through the teachings of the other Paraclete and the guidance these teachings bring to our lives. Truth is the one stable factor in times of uncertainty. Don't lose heart! Don't be troubled! Don't be afraid! God will help us.

Did you know that this song comes from a parable that Jesus told during the Sermon on the Mount?



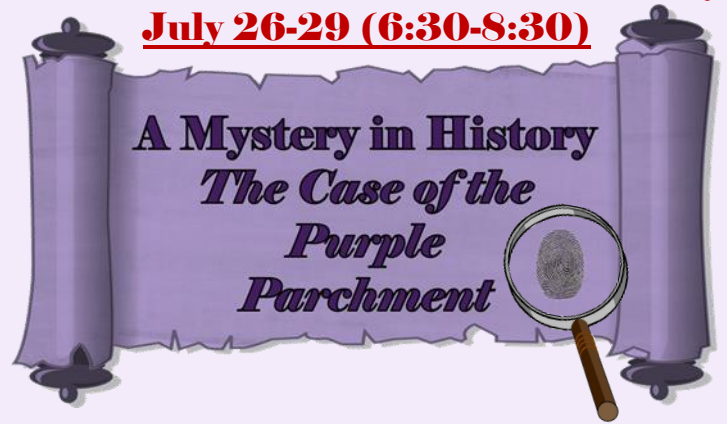
Professor Dynamite will be looking at this parable and what it really means. Do you think the Professor will understand the parable, or will he have to learn it the hard way?

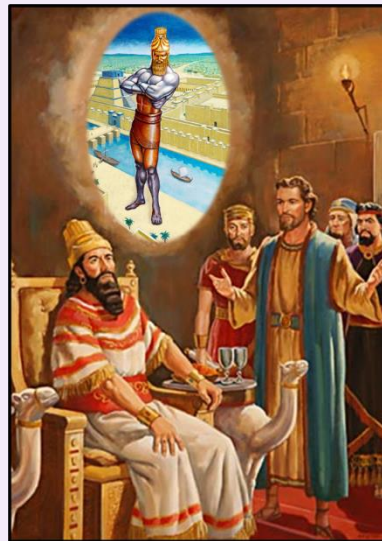
