A Daily Ministry (Hebrews 3:13) - Attitude of an Encourager

"Whether you are a man or woman, you will never do anything in this world without courage."

God told His new leader, "*Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.*" (Joshua 1:9) Did God discourage Joshua or encourage him?

It took courage to lead God's people into enemy land. God knew that, so He encouraged Joshua. Paul was in prison when He wrote His epistle to the church at Ephesus. He told them to "*be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might*" (Ephesians 6:10). Did Paul discourage his brothers and sisters because of his situation? It took courage for them to live by faith in the first century.

There are many other examples in the Scriptures where someone had two main choices in speaking or writing. They could speak words of encouragement or discouragement. We are positioned in the lives of others at different times. We can use those moments to encourage or discourage them. What do you do in those moments? Do you play "devil's advocate" or "what if" or "explore the negative only"? I believe the answer to what we say and do lies with our attitude.

You know it's not easy to live as Christians and stand for the truth. It's difficult to try to share one's faith and stick yourself out there for rejection. It takes courage and encouragement from others. Encouragement is the fuel for our courage. God knew Joshua needed encouragement.

Paul knew the church at Ephesus needed encouragement. Do we see the need to live courageously in this day and time?

It begins with the right attitude.

Kidspiration Kids


Hey Kids! Professor Dynamite is back! It's Father's Day. So, the professor's video will focus on fathers and children. Be sure to get your father and watch the video together.



