Activity of an Encourager*

Acts 4:32-37 (NKJV)

32 Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. 33 And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all. 34 Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, 35 and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.

36 And Joses, who was also named Barnabas by the apostles (which is translated Son of Encouragement), a Levite of the country of Cyprus, 37 having land, sold it, and brought the money and laid it at the apostles' feet.

A Daily Ministry (Hebrews 3:13) - Activity of an Encourager

Have you ever been given a name besides the one you received at birth? Maybe it was given because of something physical. You were shorter than others, and you were called “shorty” or “smalls”. You wore glasses and were called “four eyes”. Maybe it was because of your abilities. This person is “athletic” or a “jock”. This person is a “geek” or “nerd”. This person is just a “weirdo”. I imagine we can relate to a name given to us whether as a child or as an adult. I was given names by family and friends. It didn’t define or determine who I was going to be. It was more for the moment in my life.

What would it mean to you if God gave you a name? Imagine the significance of God changing your name like He did with Abram, Jacob, and Simon. In a way, He has provided a new name and identity. It comes when we accept the Lord’s invitation and realize our sinful nature. We believe, confess, repent, and immerse in the water. When we come up out of the water, we change. It’s not noticeable by sight. It is by faith. We add a new identity. We still have our birth name, but we are now called “*Christian*”. The name “*Christian*” is more than just a name; it’s our identity. The disciples were first called “*Christians*” in Antioch. Barnabas and Saul had spent a year teaching in Antioch.

In that time, the given name “*Christian*” began.

Barnabas had experience with a given name. His original name was “*Joses*” or “*Joseph*”. The apostles gave him the name “*Barnabas*” meaning “son of encouragement”. A series on encouragement would not be complete if Barnabas was not mentioned. Barnabas is a worthy example of the “Activity of an Encourager”. He demonstrated the name given to him. We don’t have to be called “*Barnabas*” to be encouraging. We do if we are called “*Christian*”.




