Daniel Series Introduction: Living Godly In An Ungodly Land

Do you find it a struggle to live with Christian morals in our culture today? How do we remain faithful to God and His Word in a world that rejects Him? How can we live courageously and confidently in a nation that doesn't seek to live under God's rule? These and other like questions have been asked by generations throughout history. We are no different today. We witness the problem of sin and it being accepted as right. We love God and love people. However, we don't want to compromise our faith. We are faced with a dilemma. We are trying to live godly in an ungodly land.

This was the situation for Daniel.

Imagine being captured by a foreign empire and taken into captivity to live in a different culture that believed and practiced much differently than you. The Babylonians, under the leadership of Nebuchadnezzar, conquered the city of Jerusalem. They looted the temple and enslaved many Jewish people. Daniel was one of those exiles. Daniel spent much of his life, not at home, but away in an ungodly land. He faced life-threatening tests, from friends in a fiery furnace to spending the night in a

den of lions. But even when the foreign culture shifted around him, Daniel never wavered in his faith. Daniel wasn't without hope. He served the same God in Whom we serve today. How do we live godly in an ungodly land? The life of Daniel gives us some guidance.

Leadership Workshop Tuesday, July 7 (6:00)


Our Leadership Workshops will continue to meet each Tuesday night in July at 6:00.


Well, it looks like the 2 of them are finally going to meet!
