Daniel Series:

*Living Godly In An Ungodly Land
Be Decisive*

Daniel 2:14-23 (NKJV)

14 Then with counsel and wisdom Daniel answered Arioch, the captain of the king's guard, who had gone out to kill the wise men of Babylon; 15 he answered and said to Arioch the king's captain, "Why is the decree from the king so urgent?" Then Arioch made the decision known to Daniel.

16 So Daniel went in and asked the king to give him time, that he might tell the king the interpretation. 17 Then Daniel went to his house, and made the decision known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his companions, 18 that they might seek mercies from the God of heaven concerning this secret, so that Daniel and his companions might not perish with the rest of the wise men of Babylon. 19 Then the secret was revealed to Daniel in a night vision. So Daniel blessed the God of heaven.

20 Daniel answered and said: "Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, For wisdom and might are His. 21 And He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives wisdom to the wise And knowledge to those who have understanding. 22 He reveals deep and secret things; He knows what is in the darkness, And light dwells with Him. 23 "I thank You and praise You, O God of my fathers; You have given me wisdom and might, And have now made known to me what we asked of You, For You have made known to us the king's demand."

Living Godly In An Ungodly Land – Be Decisive

“What do you want to do?” “I don't know, whatever you want to do.” “What sounds good to eat?” “I don't know. Anything really.” “What about McDonalds?” “No, I don't want a hamburger or french fries.” “What about pizza?” “No, I'm not in the mood for that either.” Does this sound familiar?

I've always had a tremendous respect for all workers on the front line. An ER doctor makes split-second decisions sometimes due to the patient's condition. A police officer has to be quick on his or her feet with a volatile situation. Our military men and women sometimes have to improvise from the plan due to heavy fire. This year, since March, seems to be one big blob of indecisive moments. Mask or no mask? Go out or stay home? Worship in person or online? Start school on time or delay? The list goes on with so many uncertain and undetermined decisions due to the lack of not knowing one day from the next.

Life doesn't always move at a snail's pace so that we can research, study, and gather all possibilities before making a decision and sticking with it. I admire Daniel and his willingness to be decisive. He was in exile along with his friends. The king was troubled by a vision that kept him from sleeping. He wanted to know the interpretation of the dream, but he wanted the “wise men” to tell him his dream and its interpretation. The king was a smart man. He knew that the “wise men” were frauds if they could not tell the king his dream. He was rashly decisive about demanding that someone explain or receive a severe consequence.

By the time Daniel found out, the king had ordered and begun killing the “wise men”. There was no time to sit, think, and figure out what to do. Daniel was decisive.



His life and his friends' lives were on the line. Life sometimes calls for us to make decisions rather quickly, due to situations. The secret to Daniel's success lies in his faithfulness to God in an ungodly land. His day-to-day life helped him in those quick decisive moments.

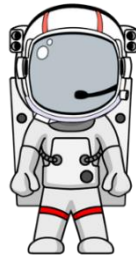

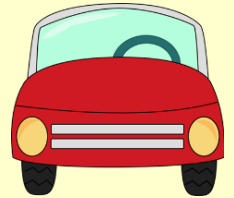


This will be a Drive-Thru VBS!
