### Daniel 4:19-22 (NKJV)

19 Then Daniel, whose name was Belteshazzar, was astonished for a time, and his thoughts troubled him. So the king spoke, and said, "Belteshazzar, do not let the dream or its interpretation trouble you."

Belteshazzar answered and said, "My lord, may the dream concern those who hate you, and its interpretation concern your enemies!

20 "The tree that you saw, which grew and became strong, whose height reached to the heavens and which could be seen by all the earth, 21 whose leaves were lovely and its fruit abundant, in which was food for all, under which the beasts of the field dwelt, and in whose branches the birds of the heaven had their home— 22 it is you, O king, who have grown and become strong; for your greatness has grown and reaches to the heavens, and your dominion to the end of the earth.

## **Living Godly In An Ungodly Land – Be Direct**

The book of Daniel is not how things happened for Daniel. We read from one extraordinary event to another. These things happened, but there was time in-between. Daniel spent over seventy years in Babylon. The book records only nine extraordinary events. The rest of the story for Daniel was guided by God in an ordinary, daily way. If we are looking to be useful to God and His ever-expanding kingdom, we need to be available to show up day after day and decade after decade in playing our part in God's orchestrated plan.

King Nebuchadnezzar received another troubling vision. It came when everything was pleasant in his life. "*I, Nebuchadnezzar, was at rest in my house and flourishing in my palace.*" (4:4) Doesn't that happen sometimes? Everything is going good until something troubling happens. (This year was going good until March.) The king was a religious man, and he had good reason to find a bad dream troubling. He needed to understand the dream so that he could act accordingly. There he was, an earthly king in the prime of his life with everything going for him but unable to act. His power ran short when it came to the meaning of the dream. He needed someone greater than himself to understand. The king knew that Daniel was one in whom "*is the Spirit of the Holy God*" (4:8). Daniel helped the king, but he needed to be direct with the king.

We live in a world where people feel invincible because their personal and professional lives are going well. Their success is not immune to personal trouble. In that hour for them, they need someone of faith to help them. Can we be as direct as Daniel to help assist them in explaining their true need of Jesus? May we be so bold to share directly with others what they need to hear. Daniel knew the meaning of the dream, but it wasn't good for the king. Daniel needed to be courageous and convicted in his faith to be so direct with the powerful king. Being direct is needed in trying to live godly in an ungodly land.


