Daniel 9:16-19 (NKJV)

16 "O Lord, according to all Your righteousness, I pray, let Your anger and Your fury be turned away from Your city Jerusalem, Your holy mountain; because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and Your people are a reproach to all those around us. 17 Now therefore, our God, hear the prayer of Your servant, and his supplications, and for the Lord's sake cause Your face to shine on Your sanctuary, which is desolate. 18 O my God, incline Your ear and hear; open Your eyes and see our desolations, and the city which is called by Your name; for we do not present our supplications before You because of our righteous deeds, but because of Your great mercies. 19 O Lord, hear! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, listen and act! Do not delay for Your own sake, my God, for Your city and Your people are called by Your name."

Living Godly In An Ungodly Land – Be Devoted

Dorothy Gale was right. There's no place like home.

Have you ever longed for home when you were away on a trip, vacation, or medical stay? Daniel relates to being away from home. He was forced into exile at a young age. He spent decades in a place that wasn't home. Yes, he made the best of his situation by living faithfully and courageously. However, this didn't stop him from missing his homeland. This burden that he felt was expressed beautifully in his prayer to God. (Chapter 9)

Throughout the book, Daniel is seen as a man of prayer. It was his first response when confronted with the news that Nebuchadnezzar's dream could not be known. It was his response when God gave him the answer to the king's dream. In the 6th chapter, Daniel found out that a decree from the king had been established that all prayers were to be made to the king for the next thirty days. Daniel went home and opened his windows toward Jerusalem and prayed on his knees three times that day. This was not something different or new for Daniel. It was his custom to pray often and daily toward Jerusalem. By the 9th chapter, Daniel established himself as being devoted to prayer. This devotion was constant, regardless of his situation remaining the same.

Of all the things about Daniel, I admire his prayer life. He was not too busy or too big to go to God in prayer. All of this was done while away from home in exile. Is your devotion to God, His word, and prayer like Daniel's? Can you continue in your prayer life regardless if your circumstance or situation don't change? I wish I could say that if you focus enough on prayer your bad situation will change. I wish I could tell you that this pandemic will all go away if we just pray three times a day. What I can tell you is that a devotion to God, His word, and prayer will change you.

This is the greater change. Be devoted.
