Sunday Night Devotional Mask-Required (August 9-16)

The elders have decided to expand the 5:00 Sunday night devotional to be a Mask-Required, condensed version of a regular Sunday night service. It will include 2 to 3 songs, prayer, scripture reading, and communion. Josh will be preaching the same sermon as the morning service.

This service is intended for those unable to attend on Sunday morning or who desire to attend a Mask-Required service.

Masks will be required to be worn at all times in the building, including during the service.

The men leading the service will be able to remove masks while at the podium.

Proper social distancing will be required and maintained, and the service will take place in the auditorium, where the pews are marked off. This service will not be live-streamed or recorded. We will re-evaluate after two weeks.

The Sunday morning worship will continue with the same format and process, including live-streaming and recordings posted to YouTube.

We hope this expanded Sunday evening devotional provides another option to worship together as a congregation during a difficult

time. Please contact any of the Elders if you have any questions, comments, or concerns.




Responding to Evangelism – Those Who Go
