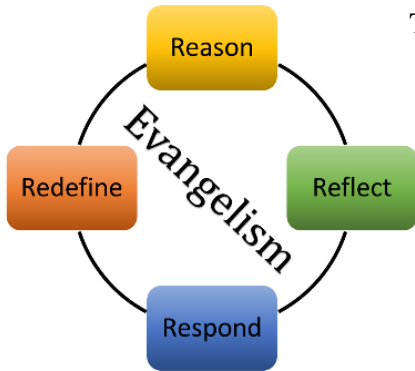

Responding to Evangelism – Approach We Take

Does it feel like the work of evangelism is like an uphill climb or battle? Does it feel like we are handicapped by someone's actions from yesterday that make it harder to reach someone today? I've encountered this more than a couple of times.

Someone is not a Christian or is not going to church service because of what someone said or did to them. For example, someone told them they were going to hell in the corner of a church building. This actually happened, and it produced poor results. If someone has had a bad experience with a church member in the past, it doesn't mean all members are the same or that it was right. This is not a good philosophy in matters of the soul. I cannot prevent other people's actions. I can say to the damaged person from a church experience that this is not a way to live.

We don't do this in matters of life that are far less important than the soul. If you have a bad day at work, you don't quit working all together because it's too important. If you have a bad experience with a doctor, you don't quit taking medicine and going to the hospital because it's too important. Why do we do this in spiritual matters? This is what I'm thinking in situations like this. I wish everyone had a good experience with Christians and the church. I wish everyone were receptive because of the great example of God's people. But this proves why we need Jesus. We are imperfect and fallible, but He lived perfectly for us. This is why the church belongs to Jesus, and He is in charge of it. The focus is on Jesus and not people. We do not need to lose heart in doing good today. Sometimes it's a walk in a park with someone. Other times it's like climbing a steep mountain. Remember that every soul matters to God. Jesus died for all. We cannot redo, but we can focus and do today.
