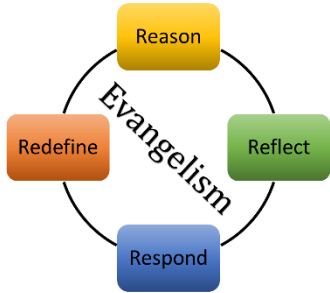

Responding to Evangelism – Motives To Go

I have no idea how many weddings I've done. I know the first wedding and premarital counseling I did ended up in divorce after three short years. Yikes! I don't know how many funerals I've officiated. I don't know the number of people I've helped in their baptism. I don't know but not because I don't care. I cared about each wedding, funeral, and conversion. I cared enough not to look at it as a statistic or number. I firmly believe in quality over quantity. I would rather have ten committed people than one hundred uncommitted people.

I believe Jesus demonstrated the importance of quality when it came to selecting only twelve to be by His side. Jesus mentioned the joy of angels over one sinner repenting. Yes, one single sinner causes Heaven to celebrate. This speaks to me about quality, not quantity. What about the value of one soul? *"For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul?"* (Matthew 16:26) The whole world is not worth the value of one soul.



Why should we go out into our neighborhoods, communities, and areas to share Jesus? It's simple! We value the one soul. Evangelism is not about filling up all the pews. It's about a soul coming to Jesus. It's knowing that one soul matters to God. It's letting our lights shine to touch that one we are able to reach.
