Potter Children's Home and Family Ministries is located in Bowling Green, Kentucky. In 1901, Clinton and Mary Potter lost their only son. They channeled their sorrow and grief into something good. Again, a reminder of God taking the bad and working together for the good. In 1914, the Potters and Trustees established the Potter Orphan home and school. God has used them to help over 7,000 children and residents in a century. They stand and live by the verse in James 1.

"Pure and undefiled religion before God is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world" (James 1:27).



Potter Children's Home and Families Ministries has called on the local churches across this nation and other nations to set aside August 30, 2020 to pray for all children.
