TODAY'S LESSON

Big Questions: What If?

Matthew 4:1-11 (NKJV)

1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. 2 And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry. 3 Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread." 4 But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.'" 5 Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, 6 and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down. For it is written: 'He shall give His angels charge over you,' and, 'In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.'" 7 Jesus said to him, "It is written again, 'You shall not tempt the Lord your God.'" 8 Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. 9 And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me." 10 Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.'" 11 Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him.

Big Questions Series: What If?

I don't remember the situation. We were young parents and facing something that seemed challenging at the time. I called and talked to Mom about it. She didn't give me any quick answers but did shed some light on my upbringing. She said, "Josh, we did the best we could with you in the time we were in." Wow! I've never forgotten those words. It was a huge nugget of wisdom coming from my beautiful mother. Was she perfect? No. Did she always make the best decision? No. She did the best she could in the time we were in.

Guess what? You will not always make the best decisions. We can always look in our past and play the game of "what if". However, we cannot go back and undo our own history. We can learn and move forward. We know that, but we can still beat ourselves up over mistakes and bad decisions we have made. Why did I do that? What was I thinking? What if I knew back then what I know now? I think "what if" questions can be damaging to our faith. We can carry "what if" into the realm of faith and spiritual thinking. What if I prayed more and did more good? Then my life wouldn't be like this. What if I read my Bible more? Then this wouldn't have happened.

After Jesus' baptism, He was led by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted. Yes, I said that right. The Holy Spirit led Him away and into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. This is not a typo or a translation problem. Jesus was tempted by the devil. I believe this makes Jesus more appealing and interesting. He faced evil in this world. He was tempted by the desires and pleasures of it. Some of the wickedness we face also faced our Lord. It is not doing enough good that will bring us immunity from evil. The solution is to endure and look to Jesus, Who is the Author and Finisher of our faith. It is not "what if" but "Who is Jesus".

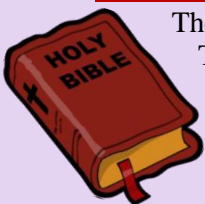
It will be taught live in-person, or you can choose to participate online through Google Meet.
