TODAY'S LESSON

Big Questions: How Will It End?

John 2:1-11 (NKJV)

1 On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. 2 Now both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding. 3 And when they ran out of wine, the mother of Jesus said to Him, "They have no wine." 4 Jesus said to her, "Woman, what does your concern have to do with Me? My hour has not yet come." 5 His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it." 6 Now there were set there six waterpots of stone, according to the manner of purification of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece. 7 Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them up to the brim. 8 And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast." And they took it. 9 When the master of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom. 10 And he said to him, "Every man at the beginning sets out the good wine, and when the guests have well drunk, then the inferior. You have kept the good wine until now!" 11 This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory; and His disciples believed in Him.

Big Questions Series: How Will It End?

“Oh no! The end is coming! Run, for your lives! Hide under the bed! Close and lock your door! Please take an item to protect yourself because the end is here!” I don’t know about you, but the idea about the end can seem like something from a cataclysmic movie. You know the one. Everything that can and will happen is bad. If I was to ask you to imagine how it will be in the end, what kind of picture would you have? Would it be pleasant, lovely, beautiful, and special? Would it be similar to going and seeing a wedding? Do you think it would be like the wedding reception? If not, you missed another picture from the Bible about how it will end. It doesn’t involve a “lake of burning fire” or “everlasting separation”. I realize those images are given as a warning in some places, but it doesn’t mean that it has to be with us who are the church.

What is the end for those who are saved in Christ Jesus? Is it something for us to fear or be afraid of? John depicts the end as a wedding feast with the groom, Jesus Christ, and the bride, His glorious church. (Revelation 19) A marriage relationship is used by Paul to describe Christ’s relationship with the church. (Ephesians 5). The first sign that Jesus performed was not with someone who is sick, dying, or demonic. The first sign was performed at a wedding feast. Have you ever questioned why there and not somewhere else first? Jesus performed His first miracle at a joyous occasion where there was no suffering or pain present. Maybe this is a sign for us because of John’s revelation that this is how it will end. Maybe we who are in Christ have the wrong image. Maybe we should be thinking of a wedding feast. If this is the case, doesn’t that fill your soul with joy? It does mine, and it doesn’t make me fear it or be afraid. The end will be far greater than the beginning.

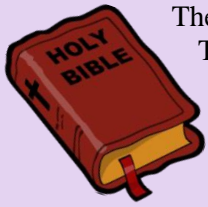


Fall Food & Supply Drive

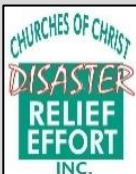
Living Like Jesus Series – “Serving Others”
