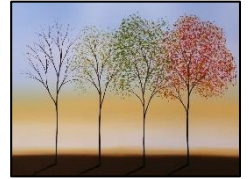

Donations for perishable food items may be made to the church office.

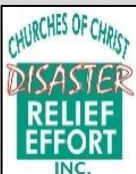
The truck is scheduled to be here to pick-up the items and donations this Tuesday, October 6th.
