Seasons of Change: From Being Stuck To Pressing On

The song "Turn! Turn! (To Everything There Is A Season)" was written in the 1950's by Pete Seeger. He was mad at his publisher, so he turned to the Bible and wrote this song in 15 minutes based on Ecclesiastes chapter 3. The song became popular by the guitar folk rock band The Byrds. The song resonated with a lot of listeners during several changes throughout the sixties decade.

The teacher of Ecclesiastes wasn't thinking about turning his words into a hit song in the 1960's. He was reflecting on the many seasons we go through in this life. There are 14 lines that contain favorable and unfavorable activities under the sun. I believe the older we get, the more we can relate to the wise teacher's words in Ecclesiastes 3. Our lives can feel like a string of seasons. It seems random days connected by the calendar, or the lack of it in 2020. I looked at our church calendar the other day for 2020, and there is nothing but an "X" from mid-March to the end of summer. There are some seasons that fly by but others that seem to drag on forever. It feels like this season of 2020 seems to be longer than most. I had a teenager tell me that she is tired of wearing masks. I said, "I thought you liked wearing a mask in the beginning". "That was then", she said.

Yes, the newness of adjusting for the year has worn off for most.



Do you feel stuck? Is this feeling based on you or the circumstances that surround you? How do we keep pressing on when it doesn't seem everyone around us is doing the same? These are all good questions and things we may be asking ourselves. Let us consider the change that God wants us to make, change that matters, the **Change From Being Stuck To Pressing On**.
