Seasons of Change: From Overscheduled to Organize

I'm currently in the middle of a book about Winston Churchill's first few years as Prime Minister of England. I'm fascinated by his ability to work at strange times. He spent a lot of time working from his bed. He would stay up to 2:00-3:00 in the morning and sleep until 7:00 in the morning. He would work in his bed from around 7:00 to 11:00 in the morning. Other notable people kept strange working schedules. Leonardo da Vinci was known to take two-hour naps whenever he got tired, regardless of the time of day. He didn't want to waste eight solid hours of sleeping every night. His sleep pattern is known as "the sleep of genius". Thomas Edison was a power napper. He strategically placed sleeping cots throughout his house and laboratory to accommodate his twenty-minute naps throughout the day. These notable people in history were able to experiment with their schedule until they found something that worked for them.

I want us to continue our thought of "Seasons of Change" by considering "From Being Overscheduled to Organize". I believe one of the blessings about the pandemic is the slowing down of our lives, especially during the quarantine time. I don't know about you, but I was able to do and be at home more than I was previously. There was no need to run and do this or that. It was refreshing, in a way, to spend my time where I needed to, with family and God.



The Bible says, "Be very careful, then, how you live - not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity" (Ephesians 5:15-16) (NIV). I've heard many people say, "I'm just too busy. I don't have any time." I want to say, but I don't, "We are in charge of our own schedules." Do you feel cluttered in our life? Do you feel overworked? Do you feel like the day owns you? In this "Season of Change", let us consider taking back our schedule and putting in place what needs to be there every day.
