Philippians 4:6-9 (NKJV)

6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Seasons of Change: From Anxiety to Peace

I was smaller. I don't know my age. We were staying at my grandmother's house when she was alive in Alabama. It was time for me to go to bed, and I begged to stay up and watch what they were watching. I continued to beg, and finally I was allowed to watch for a while. I don't know why I begged because something scared me from the show. It involved kidnapping, and I was afraid. I was sent to bed. I woke up scared from a horrible nightmare later at night. I thought somebody was going to come in and take me away. I called out for my father. He graciously came and sat in a chair until I was sound asleep. I should have listened the first time.

I wonder what percentage of being anxious or scared is because of what we have allowed to come into our minds and hearts. Did we think we could handle something when we weren't really able? Do we feel we can endure the troubles of this world and still remain calm and cool? The older I get the more I see the wisdom in verses that focus on the mind. We are to set our minds on things above. (Colossians 3:2) We are to meditate on anything that is praiseworthy, lovely, noble, true, and of a good report. (Philippians 4:8) I believe information can be just as scary as events in our lives. God made us, and He knows us intimately. He has provided us with information and things to think about rather than what people create and do. Jesus didn't come to earth and die for us so that we can live in fear and be plagued by anxious thoughts.



We conclude our "Season of Change" with looking at the change from being anxious to having peace. The "Peace of God" is so appealing after facing life on my own. It is refreshing to know what we can receive from God and His word - the peace of mind that goes beyond the understanding of this life. Change is inevitable. How you face it and deal with it is the question. We need to be in the mindset to think on better things. We need to go from being anxious to having the peace of God.

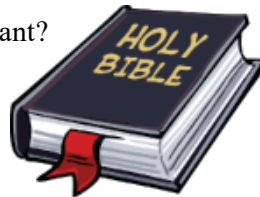
This week, we are beginning a new series in our Sunday School class entitled **"Holy, Holy, Holy"**.
