The History of Veterans Day (Formerly Armistice Day)

Over 100 years ago, World War I officially ended on June 28, 1919, when the Treaty of Versailles was signed in the Palace of Versailles in France. The fighting, however, had stopped 7 months earlier when an armistice (a temporary termination of hostilities) began on the **11th Hour of the 11th Day of the 11th Month.**

It is due to this armistice that November 11, 1918, is regarded as the end of “The Great War”.



President Wilson proclaimed November 11 as **Armistice Day** in November 1919, speaking these words, “To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country’s service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations...”

On June 4, 1926, the United States Congress passed a concurrent resolution with the following words, **Whereas** the 11th of November 1918, marked the cessation of the most destructive, sanguinary, and far reaching war in human annals and the resumption by the people of the United States of peaceful relations with other nations, which we hope may never again be severed, and

Whereas it is fitting that the recurring anniversary of this date should be commemorated with thanksgiving and prayer and exercises designed to perpetuate peace through good will and mutual understanding between nations; and

Whereas the legislatures of twenty-seven of our States have already declared November 11 to be a legal holiday:

Therefore be it Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives concurring), that the President of the United States is requested to issue a proclamation calling upon the officials to display the flag of the United States on all Government buildings on November 11 and inviting the people of the United States to observe the day in schools and churches, or other suitable places, with appropriate ceremonies of friendly relations with all other peoples.

In 1954, President Eisenhower officially changed the name of the holiday from **Armistice Day** to **Veterans Day**.

Let us celebrate this Veterans Day with Thanksgiving and Prayer to God and in honor of those who have served.
