Enough

“Now godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. And having food and clothing with these we shall be content.” (1 Timothy 6:6-8)

Before I look at this powerful passage from Paul, I need to address the “elephant in the room”. No, it’s not the election or what is happening with the election. It’s the “behemoth force” that gradually takes over more and more. I’m talking about the Christmas season. I wondered what would happen with us still being in a pandemic. The stores have extended “Black Friday” to a month-long sale event. The trees and decoration have been out since October, maybe earlier in some places. They took away “Charlie Brown’s Thanksgiving” special from airing on the major TV stations. We need that special more than ever this year. I enjoy Christmas and shopping for family, but I love the season and meaning of “Thanksgiving”. It’s not a time of getting candy or gifts but of gathering together and being thankful for the people in your life over a well-cooked meal.

It’s a strong visual reminder of the great blessings in our lives.

I want to focus on Thanksgiving for the next three Sundays. Our main text is 1 Timothy 6. I want us to focus on the word “Enough”. We hear it and say it plenty of times to know when we do or do not have enough. How do you know you have enough? What has God said about the subject? Is His view of enough different or the same as my view of enough? I believe each of us has more than enough. This is not to make us feel guilty or feel shameful. However, we should reflect more on what we already have rather than what we want to have.



According to Paul, “godliness with contentment” is great gain. It’s not how much stuff you have. It’s not how many trips you go on. It’s not how many times you eat out. What is Paul’s answer to Timothy regarding when someone has enough? He said, *“having food and clothing with these we shall be content”*. I believe we all have much more than these two things. Does having more than food and clothing make us more content? Are we the most content people who have ever lived? It seems strange, but it’s true. The more we have doesn’t mean the happier we are. I want us to celebrate a thankful life better by knowing when Enough is Enough.
