Enough Series: Less Than Enough

Luke 16:19-25 (NKJV)

19 "There was a certain rich man who was clothed in purple and fine linen and fared sumptuously every day. 20 But there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, full of sores, who was laid at his gate, 21 desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table. Moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. 22 So it was that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died and was buried. 23 And being in torments in Hades, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. 24 "Then he cried and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.' 25 But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted and you are tormented.

Less Than Enough

Jesus prayed, "Give us this day our daily bread." (Matthew 6:11)
Paul wrote, "And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content." (I Timothy 6:8)
We talked about having more than enough. What does having "Less Than Enough" mean?

I vividly remember my experience in Tanzania, Africa. I was blessed to go deep into the bush and spend time with the people there. I saw dirt roads, the basic shell of a small mudbrick home, torn clothes, and nothing green because of the dry season. I saw a young boy with a stick pushing a bicycle wheel up and down the road. He didn't have a complete bike. He appeared to be content and happy. More than once I've seen people with less than enough who were more satisfied than those who have more than enough.

What does "Less Than Enough" mean with God? Why is it important for us to identify and know what "Less Than Enough" means? We don't have to go across the world to see "Less Than Enough". We can go down Charlotte and find people living in tents. There are people in our neighborhoods who have "Less Than Enough". Jesus talked about those with "Less Than Enough". Let us be open to our Lord's teaching and consider those who are homeless, jobless, and struggling to make it from day to day. The purpose of this lesson is not to solve this problem because Jesus reminds us that the poor we will always have with us. However, we can make a difference. It begins when we realize Enough is Enough.

Here's how it will work.

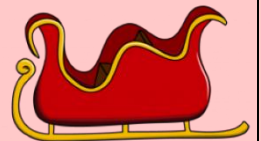
Meals will be served in Rotations.
